2017 Ruth D. Corcoran Scholarship

PURPOSE:

To provide scholarships to graduating high school seniors who plan to pursue a career in Nursing.

REQUIREMENTS: Please submit the following documents for committee review:

- 1.) Completed application form and short-essay questionnaire.
- 2.) Copy of high school transcript including applicant's GPA and ACT/SAT score.
- 3.) A minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and a minimum score of 20 ACT **or** 100 PAX RN / PAX PN **or** 1400 SAT
- 4.) Two (2) letters of recommendation. *At least one recommendation letter **must** be from a teacher or counselor from the applicant's current high school. The second letter may come from a nurse, another teacher, counselor, employer or community/church leader.*

SELECTION CRITERIA:

A selection committee at Galen College of Nursing will choose the recipients of this scholarship based on the merit of candidate using the criteria described above. Scholarship award will be presented by a Galen representative during the Honors Ceremony or Graduation.

AWARD:

Scholarship awards up to \$3,000 will be paid directly toward total tuition cost of the recipient's selected nursing program at Galen College of Nursing.

DEADLINE:

The due date for scholarship application is **March 10, 2017**. The student's application and transcript must be received by March 10, 2017. Any incomplete or missing information will disqualify the application. You may submit your application via USPS or electronically to one of the addresses listed below.

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ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS:

- 1.) Award must be accepted and initiated within the 2017/2018 school year
- 2.) Award is non-transferrable.
- 3.) Award may only be applied toward tuition at Galen College of Nursing
- 4.) Award will be divided evenly over the length of the program
- 5.) Award recipient **MUST** maintain a 2.5 GPA throughout the length of the program
- 6.) Award recipient will be allowed one term of probation if their cumulative GPA falls below 2.5. Following the probationary term, award eligibility will be lost if the student's cumulative GPA remains below 2.5

AWARDING PROCESS:

The Galen College of Nursing Scholarship Committee will notify high schools and scholarship recipients by April 7, 2017.
