4. Applicant must submit application package. Package must consist of application form with essay. Essay is to be typed or neatly handwritten. It is to be double-spaced and no more than 500 words. The essay is to be on the following topic: "What I have learned from being a volunteer".
5. Submit at least one letter of recommendation from a volunteer organization.
6. Submit a picture of yourself (preferably senior picture) for publishing purposes in local newspaper upon winning.
7. Awarded scholarships will only be paid when students present proof of Enrollment. We ask that students pick up and cash the check by the end of the year in which awarded.
